The Land Trust Accreditation Commission, an independent program of the Land Trust Alliance, conducts an extensive review of each applicant's policies and programs. The Commission invites public input and accepts signed, written comments on pending applications. Comments must relate to how Cornwall Conservation Trust, Inc. complies with national quality standards. These standards address the ethical and technical operation of a land trust.
